**PREOPERATIVE DIAGNOSIS:** Screening colonoscopy.

**POSTOPERATIVE DIAGNOSES:**

1. Internal and external hemorrhoids.
2. Sigmoid diverticulosis.
3. Descending colon polyp x2.
4. Sigmoid colon polyp x1.

**PROCEDURE:** Colonoscopy with multiple hot biopsy polypectomies, 45384.

**FINDINGS:** All three polyps were retrieved and sent for permanent pathologic analysis.

**BRIEF HISTORY:** This 67-year-old white male who was referred by Dr. Steven Fern for screening colonoscopy.

**INFORMED CONSENT:** I have discussed risks, benefits, side effects, and reasonable alternatives, including possible results of not receiving treatment, potential problems related to recuperation and the likelihood of achieving goals with the patient/caregivers. Informed consent was obtained.

**DESCRIPTION OF PROCEDURE:** The patient was brought to the endoscopy site with IV access in place. Once a adequate level of IV sedation had been administered and appropriate monitoring modalities attached, a digital rectal exam was performed. The scope was inserted to the level of the cecum. Confirmation was obtained by visualizing the ileocecal valve and appendiceal orifice. The scope was slowly withdrawn. Retroflexion was performed in the rectum.

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The patient was then taken to the recovery room in stable condition having tolerated the procedure well with no complications.
